- Tip no: 2.


 Is just one newspaper or website reporting on the story? Try to find at least three sources of information.

Tip no: 3.

Is the story missing key information? Most publications try to speak with at least two sources to make sure the story is true.

- **Tip no: 4.**
 - Does the website look professional?

 Does the site's URL match the product's or company's name? Are there misspellings?
